The applicant must have an affiliation to Elko First Presbyterian Church to be considered for this scholarship. Preference will be given to applicants whose resume and essays show outstanding organization, presentation, and qualities reflected by Reverend Bolin during his lifetime.

- Scholarship awards will be up to \$500.00 a semester (as defined by institution).
 Proof of enrollment will ensure prompt payment to the recipient. The awarding of the second semester scholarship is contingent upon receipt of an <u>OFFICAL</u> <u>TRANSCRIPT</u> indicating a cumulative 3.0 GPA for the previous semester.
- 3. When reapplying for the RBMS, all parts of the application must be submitted. Please include an **updated** statement of faith and **current** references. The scholarship is renewable only one time.
